Do you have a student in the sixth, seventh or eighth grade? If your child enjoys the outdoors, the NRDs have just the place for them to be this summer. Have them attend Adventure Camp About the Environment, also known as ACE camp; which promises both fun and adventure while learning about the environment. This is the first year the Natural Resources Districts have offered the ACE camp. We'll focus on things like water resources, soil and land, forestry, range and grassland, wildlife and aquatics. In high school, students will have the opportunity to compete in the Envirothon, which tests students on these very same topics.

During the ACE camp, students will roll up their sleeves and dig into nature. They'll also enjoy the environment by canoeing, climbing, water sliding and other adventures. Professionals will be there to introduce them to possible careers in the area of natural resources.
