### **8. MANAGERS' REPORTS**

a. Outreach. Russell reported that they were almost complete with the edits to the Irrigation Leader Magazine article.

b. Grants. They have applied for another grant for 1,000 more meters so waiting to hear on that.

Johnson reported they installed 8 more weather stations last week for a total of 12. She will be emailing out the user id and password to the board members so they can monitor them as well. Once all the weather stations are in, she will put together a press release for the public.

### 9. NATURAL RESOUCES CONSERVATION SERVICE (NRCS) – KENNEDY.

Working on getting people paid for projects that were completed. Finished up 225 CRP contracts between Frontier, Red Willow, Hitchcock and Hayes counties. They have heard that they will begin Phase 4 of the COVID-19 restriction lift either this week or the next but are currently using their own guidelines which include by appointment only and wearing a mask upon entry.

### **10. NEBRASKA ASSOCIATION OF RESOURCES DISTRICTS (NARD) - RIPPEN.**

Annual Conference was cancelled. Their meeting is currently scheduled for September 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>. Discussion was held. Anderjaska explained some details of how the association works for a few that had questions.
